ORDER APPOINTING TESTAMENTARY GUARDIAN

WHEREAS, the last will and testament of _____, deceased, was duly admitted to probate by the Surrogate of the County of _____, on the _____ day of _____, 20_____, in and by which will _____ is named as the testamentary guardian of _____, the infant,

AND WHEREAS, _____ has taken and filed the oath of office, and has filed a bond, pursuant to law, for the faithful discharge of his duty as such testamentary guardian; and we being satisfied of the sufficiency of the bond, and that _____ is a good and reputable person, and is in every respect competent to have the custody of the person and estate of the infant, do by these presents allow, constitute and appoint _____ testamentary guardian of the person and estate of the infant, during his minority, hereby requiring the guardian to safely keep the real and personal estate of the infant, which shall hereafter come into his custody, and not suffer any waste, sale or destruction of the property, but to keep up and sustain his lands, tenements, and hereditaments by and with the rents, issues and profits thereof, or with such other moneys belonging to him as shall come into his possession, and to deliver the property to him when he becomes of full age, or to such other guardian as may hereafter be appointed, in as good order and condition as he receives it, and also to render a just and true account of all moneys and property secured by him, and the application thereof, and of his guardianship in all respects, to any court having cognizance thereof when thereunto required.
